### SHARED VAN SERVICE FROM ALL AIRPORTS

*Super Shuttle*, or another van service recommended by the Transportation Desk is an ideal way to travel to the hostel. After collecting your baggage, go to the Ground Transportation Desk or look for signs to the shared van departure point. The cost is approximately \$20 per passenger, and the driver will drop you off at the hostel entrance.

#### TRAIN/SUBWAY

- From Kennedy Airport (JFK) Traveling by subway is the cheapest route but may be more stressful as you must carry your bags up and down stairs in busy underground stations. If you are up the adventure, take the AirTrain green line to Howard Beach Station for \$5. Transfer to the blue A Train towards Manhattan for \$2.75. Exit at the 59th St. Columbus Circle Station and Transfer to the red #1 train. Take the #1 train uptown to the 103rd St. Station. Walk one street east to the hostel on Amsterdam Ave.
- From Newark Aiport (EWR) Take *AirTrain* to Penn Station for \$13.00 (about 30 minutes). Once at Penn Station, take a taxi (\$10-\$20) or subway (\$2.75) to the hostel. If taking the subway, catch the red #1 train (red line) uptown and get off at 103rd St. Station for \$2.75. Walk one street east to the hostel on Amsterdam Ave.

#### <u>BUS</u>

- From Kennedy Airport (JFK) Take the *NYC Airporter* to the Port Authority Bus Terminal. Buy tickets at the Ground Transportation Welcome Center. The trip takes about 1 hour and costs \$17. Once at the Port Authority, take a taxi or subway to get to the hostel. A taxi from Port Authority will cost between \$10-15 (including tip); the subway will cost \$2.75. If you choose the subway, take the #1 train (red line) uptown and get off at 103rd St. Station. Walk one block east to the hostel on Amsterdam Ave.
- From LaGuardia Airport (LGA) The bus the easiest and cheapest way to get to the hostel from La Guardia. Take the M60 bus which departs every 30 minutes. The cost is \$2.75 (you must have exact change & pay before boarding) and takes about 45 minutes. Get off at 105th/106th Streets on Broadway and walk south until you reach 103<sup>rd</sup> St. and then one block east to the hostel on Amsterdam Ave.

#### YELLOW TAXI

The most expensive way to travel to the hostel is by taxi, unless you are traveling in groups of 3 or more. If you choose this method, only use official yellow taxis. <u>Do not</u> accept rides from illegal taxi drivers who will approach you in the baggage department. They will charge you outrageous fees.

- ➤ From Kennedy Airport (JFK) Approximately \$55 (plus suggested \$5 tip)
- From LaGuardia Aiport (LGA) Approximately \$40 (plus suggested \$3 tip)
- From Newark Airport (EWR) Approximately \$70 (plus suggested \$5 tip)
