

# How Do I Get To...



## The Port Authority 42nd Street and 8th Avenue

Plan on leaving the Hostel at least 3 hours prior to the departure of your bus.

**By Taxi:** A taxi from the Hostel to the Port Authority costs approximately \$15. If you go in groups of 3 or 4 people, it is very affordable and easier than the subway. The best place to get a taxi is on Broadway. Be sure to tip the taxi driver about \$3.

**By Subway:** Walk to the subway station at Broadway and 103rd Street. Buy a subway pass for \$2.75 at the ticket machine and take the Broadway local #1 train downtown to 42nd Street/Times Square station. Once off the train, walk down the stairs from the platform and follow signs to the Port Authority. You will walk in an underground passageway for about 5 minutes. At the end of the walkway, turn left if you are looking for the South Wing (Bonanza, Shortline, or Adirondack Trailways buses) and turn right if you are looking for the North Wing (Greyhound, New Jersey Transit and Airport Buses). Pass through the turnstiles to exit the subway station in order to enter the Port Authority. There are information booths just inside the building if you need specific directions. To find the Airport Buses – look for the “Gray Line” Sign. Please only ask uniformed attendants for help and instructions.



## Penn Station 32nd Street and 7th Avenue

Plan on leaving the Hostel at least 3 hours prior to the departure of your train.

**By Taxi:** A taxi to Penn Station costs approximately \$20. If you go in groups of 3 or 4 people, it is very affordable and easier than the subway. The best place to get a taxi is on Broadway. Be sure to tip the taxi driver about \$3.

**By Subway:** Walk to the subway station located at Broadway and 103rd Street. Buy a subway pass for \$2.75 at the ticket machine and take the Broadway local #1 train downtown to 34th Street/Penn Station. When you get off the train, follow signs for Penn Station and follow signs to your train company.



## Grand Central Station 42nd Street and Park Avenue

Plan on leaving the Hostel about 3 hours prior to the departure of your train.

**By Taxi:** A taxi to Grand Central Station costs approximately \$15. If you go in groups of 3 or 4 people, it is very affordable and easier than the subway. The best place to get a taxi is on Broadway. Be sure to tip the taxi driver about \$2.

**By Subway:** Walk to the subway station located at Broadway and 103rd Street. Buy a subway pass for \$2.75 at the ticket machine in the station and take the Broadway local #1 train downtown to 42nd Street/Times Square Station. Once off the train, walk down the steps from the platform and follow signs for the ‘S’ or Shuttle train. Take the S train to the Grand Central Station stop. When you get off the train, go up one level of stairs. Walk towards the main hall to buy tickets and get information.



## New York Area Airports JFK, LaGuardia & Newark

Shared van shuttle service may be booked through the hostel at the help desk in the lobby. If you want to take public transportation, plan on departing 4 hours prior to the departure time of your flight.

**JFK Airport:** Go to the Port Authority using the directions above. Go to the North Wing of the Port Authority and look for signs for the Airport Bus Center (look for the “Gray Line” signs). At the airport buses area, buy a ticket to JFK for \$16. The bus leaves right outside of the airport buses area. A taxi to JFK costs about \$60 (including toll). Be sure to tip the driver about \$5.

**LaGuardia Airport:** This airport is closest to the Hostel. On Broadway in between 106th & 107th St is a bus stop for the M60 bus. Buses depart every 20 minutes and will take you to the airport. The cost for the ride is \$2.75 in exact change (get 11 silver quarters before leaving). The bus trip takes about 1 hour. If you take a taxi, it will cost about \$40, plus a \$3 suggested tip.

**Newark Airport:** Follow the directions above to Penn Station. When you arrive at Penn Station, follow the signs to NJ Transit and purchase a ticket to Newark Airport for \$12.50. Train schedules are available at [www.njtransit.com](http://www.njtransit.com).
